Overview

All ports on patch panels and all positions on termination blocks shall be labelled with the corresponding port number or position number and optionally with additional identifier fields as practicable. Use the separate numeric keypad for quick entry of numbers. Port numbering, strip printing, faceplate identification, and the labelling workflow that keeps your network documentation accurate after moves, adds, and changes.
