

How to operate a card-type optical splitter

A card-type optical splitter is installed in a patch panel or ODF to divide a single optical signal into multiple outputs, ensuring even signal distribution without requiring power.

Understanding the Card-Type Optical Splitter

A card-type optical splitter is a passive device that splits one incoming optical signal into multiple outputs or combines multiple inputs into one fiber. It typically uses Planar Lightwave Circuit (PLC) technology, which provides uniform signal distribution, supports high split ratios (e.g., 1×16, 1×32), and is compact enough to fit into optical distribution frames or patch panels. Unlike FBT splitters, PLC splitters are more stable and suitable for large-scale deployments.

Installation Steps

- Prepare the Patch Panel or ODF: Ensure the card slot is clean and free of dust. Card-type splitters are designed to slide into standard optical distribution frames or panels.
- Clean Fiber Ends: Use fiber cleaning tools to remove dust or contaminants from both the input and output fibers. Proper cleaning prevents signal loss and reflection.
- Insert the Splitter Card: Slide the card-type splitter into the designated slot in the panel. Ensure it is securely seated and aligned with the fiber connectors.
- Connect Input Fiber: Attach the main fiber from the central office or OLT to the input port of the splitter. Typically, SC/APC connectors are used for PON networks, but LC or SC/UPC may also be compatible
