

How to test a whole reel of optical cable

Testing an optical cable reel involves verifying its length, attenuation, and integrity using tools like OTDRs, optical fault locators, and power meters before installation.

Step 1: Visual and Physical Inspection

Before any measurements, inspect the reel for physical damage, cracks, or irregularities along the cable. Check the manufacturer's specifications and ensure the cable type, length, and quantity match the delivery documents. Confirm that the cable has not been exposed to excessive bending or crushing during transport .

Step 2: Prepare Testing Equipment

You will need:

- Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) for detecting faults, breaks, and measuring attenuation.
- Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS) or power meter with light source for measuring total loss.
- Visual Fault Locator (VFL) for identifying breaks or tight bends.
- Optional: fiber pigtails and temporary splices for connecting bare fibers . Ensure all instruments are calibrated and that you have clean connectors and proper adapters.

Step 3: Length Verification

Connect the OTDR or optical fault locator to a fiber at the free end of the reel. Meas...
