

How to unplug the router in fiber optic broadband

- For SC connectors, press the push-pull latch.
- For LC connectors, squeeze the clip or latch.
- For other types, follow the manufacturer's instructions to disengage the connector safely . 6. Pull the Connector Straight Out: Gently pull the connector along its axis w...
