

How to use an outdoor network cable terminal box

An outdoor network cable terminal box is used to terminate, protect, and manage network cables outdoors, ensuring reliable connections while shielding them from environmental damage.

Choosing the Right Terminal Box

Select a box with a high IP rating (at least IP65, ideally IP68) to ensure it is waterproof, dustproof, and UV-resistant. The material should be durable, such as polycarbonate + ABS blends or SMC, with impact resistance to withstand outdoor conditions. Ensure the box has enough space for your cable splices, adapters, and any splitters you may need.

Preparing the Cables

Use outdoor-rated Ethernet or fiber optic cables. For Ethernet, choose CMX-rated cables with LLDPE or HDPE jackets for UV and moisture resistance. For buried runs, use direct burial cables with water-blocking gel or tape. Measure the cable run carefully, allowing extra length for bends and terminations.

Mounting the Box

Install the terminal box on a wall, pole, or other stable structure. Ensure it is mounted vertically and at a height that prevents water pooling or accidental damage. Use scr...
