

How to use ceramic ferrule polishing paste

Ceramic ferrule polishing paste, often diamond-based, is used to achieve a smooth, scratch-free fiber end-face for optimal optical performance.

Purpose and Function

Ceramic ferrules, typically made from zirconia, hold and align optical fibers in connectors such as SC, LC, and FC types. Polishing paste is applied during the final stages of fiber termination to remove surface imperfections, scratches, and epoxy residues, ensuring minimal signal loss, low back reflection, and stable fiber-to-fiber contact. The paste works by gently abrading the fiber end-face and ferrule surface to produce a precise convex or radiused geometry required by industry standards like Telcordia GR-326 and IEC 61300-3-35.

Types of Polishing Paste

- **Diamond Polishing Paste:** Contains fine diamond particles suspended in a binder, ideal for high-precision polishing of ceramic ferrules. It is available in various grit sizes, from coarse (e.g., 30 μm) for shaping to ultra-fine (e.g., 0.01 μm) for final polishing. Diamond pastes are preferred because they cut through ceramic efficiently without causing undercutting or surface contamination.
- **Silicon Dioxide or Silicon Carbide Pastes:** Used in some lapping films or final polishing sheets. Silicon dioxide sheets provide a smooth finish with minimal scratches and no binder contamination, while silicon carbide can be more aggressiv...
