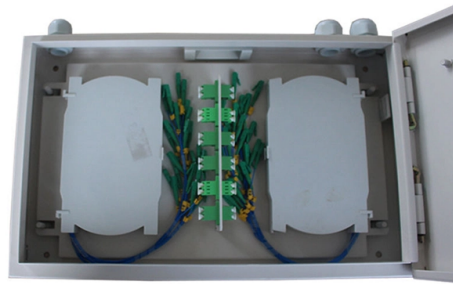


How to use multiple fiber optic terminal boxes

- **Select Box Type:** Options include straight-through, branched, wall-mounted, rack-mounted, or desktop types. Outdoor boxes often include lockable latches and hinged doors for security and maintenance .

Installation Steps

- **Mounting:** Secure each box to a wall, rack, or pole using appropriate anchors or screws. Ensure the box is level and accessible for future maintenance .
- **Cable Preparation and Entry:** Strip the outer sheath of incoming cables carefully, exposing buffer tubes and fibers without nicking them. Feed cables through glands or entry ports and tighten for strain relief and environmental sealing
