

How to use the black box on the optical fiber cable



Article Overview

To connect a fiber optic black box (termination box), carefully prepare the cables, insert them into the designated ports, secure the connections, and test signal integrity.

Preparation

- **Gather Tools and Materials:** You will need the fiber termination box, fiber optic cables, fiber adapters, cable cutters and strippers, labeling tape, cleaning agents, gloves, and a fiber optic tester .
- **Inspect Cables:** Check all fiber optic cables for damage or defects and lay them flat to avoid tangling .
- **Determine Cable Lengths:** Measure and trim cables to the required length for each connection .

Installation Steps

- **Select Installation Location:** Choose a wall, cable rack, or other accessible location, leaving at least 20 cm of space for cable storage .
- **Mount the Box:** Secure the fiber termination box using expansion screws or other suitable fasteners, ensuring it is stable and level .
- **Prepare Fiber Ends:** Strip the fiber jacket, clean the fiber with alcohol or a specialized cleaner, and ensure the fiber end is smooth and free of debris .
- **Connect Fibers:** Open the connector cover of the box, insert each fiber into its corresponding port or adapter, and ensure proper alignment. Avoid sharp bends or pinching to maintain signal quality
