

Incoming line to distribution box 220



Article Overview

The incoming line to a 220V distribution box typically consists of two hot wires, a neutral wire, and a ground wire, connected through a main breaker to safely distribute power to circuits.

Components of the Incoming Line

For a standard single-phase 220V residential distribution box, the incoming line includes:

- Two Hot Wires (L1 and L2): These carry 220V AC power from the utility or main service panel. They are usually black and red in color and are connected to the main double-pole circuit breaker ().
- Neutral Wire (N): Typically blue or white, this wire completes the circuit for any 120V components within appliances or devices and is connected to the neutral bus bar ().
- Ground Wire (PE): Green or yellow-green, this wire provides a safety path for fault currents and is connected to the grounding terminal or rod ().

Wiring Configuration

- Main Breaker Connection: The two hot wires enter the main breaker, which controls the overall power supply to the distribution box. This breaker must be rated according to the total load, commonly 30A-50A for household appliances ().
- Neutral and Ground Terminals: The neutral wire is pressed to the neutral terminal block, and the ground wire is pressed to the grounding terminal block. This ensures proper safety and circuit completion ()...
