

Incoming lines to multi-channel distribution box



Article Overview

Incoming lines are the primary power feeders that bring electricity into a distribution box, connecting to busbars or incomer devices to supply multiple outgoing circuits safely and efficiently.

Overview of Incoming Lines

Incoming lines are the cables or conductors that carry electrical power from the main service or utility source into a distribution box. In multi-channel or multi-circuit distribution boxes, these lines are critical because they determine the capacity, safety, and efficiency of the entire electrical system (). They can be single-line or multiple-line, depending on whether the system has a normal supply and a backup supply ().

Components of Incoming Lines

- Phase Lines: Typically three in a three-phase system (A, B, C), carrying the main current. Standard color codes are yellow for A phase, green for B phase, and red for C phase ().
- Neutral Line: Provides the return path for current and balances unbalanced loads, usually colored blue ().
- Ground Wire: Safety conductor with yellow-green stripes, providing a path to earth in case of faults ().
