Incompletely fused ports occur when fiber connections in a terminal box are not fully spliced or aligned, leading to increased insertion loss, signal degradation, and potential long-term network instability.

Causes of Incompletely Fused Ports

Incompletely fused ports typically result from improper fiber splicing or termination during installation. Common causes include:

- Poor fiber preparation: Inadequate stripping, cleaning, or cleaving of fiber ends can prevent proper fusion with pigtails or adapters .
- Misalignment in adapters or splice trays: Fibers not seated correctly in SC, LC, or FC adapters can leave gaps or partial contact .
- Mechanical stress or bending: Routing fibers below the minimum bend radius or improper strain relief can shift fibers, causing incomplete fusion over time .
- Environmental factors: Moisture ingress or temperature fluctuations can affect the integrity of the fusion point if the terminal box is not properly sealed .
