

Installation and Construction of Fire-Resistant Cable Trays

Fire-resistant cable trays should be installed using approved materials, proper routing, secure mounting, and firestopping measures to ensure safety and compliance with standards.

Planning and Layout

Proper installation begins with route planning. Cable trays should follow the shortest and straightest path, avoiding unnecessary crossings or detours, and should be coordinated with the building structure to prevent interference with other pipelines or systems. Power and signal cables must be segregated using dedicated trays to reduce electromagnetic interference and maintain system reliability ().

Material Selection

For fire-resistant applications, hot-dip galvanized steel or stainless steel trays are preferred due to their durability, corrosion resistance, and fire performance. Indoor installations may use painted steel or galvanized trays, while outdoor or high-humidity environments may require stainless steel, aluminum alloy, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic trays (). Tray width and thickness should be selected based on cable quantity and weight to prevent deformation under full load.
