

Installation of 24-core fiber optic cable for smart buildings in Poland



Article Overview

24-core fiber optic cables enable high-speed, reliable connectivity and full integration of smart building systems, supporting FTTH and KNX automation networks.

Planning and Design

For smart buildings, the installation of 24-core fiber optic cables begins with network planning. Key considerations include the number of floors, expected bandwidth, and integration with building automation systems such as KNX. Structured cabling follows a hierarchical design, starting from the central building entry point, through vertical conduits, to floor distribution points, ensuring efficient routing and minimal signal loss. Optical attenuation should be calculated, with a maximum of 0.35 dB/km for OS2 fibers at 1310 nm wavelength.

Cable Selection and Components

A 24-core fiber cable is suitable for medium to large smart buildings, allowing multiple services and redundancy. Modern splice boxes and cassettes accommodate 12 or 24 fibers per unit, enabling high packing density and space efficiency in 1U rack units. Components such as splitters, media converters, and modular splice systems are selected based on the building's FTTH and automation requirements. Media converters allow KNXnet/IP protocols to run over optical fiber with latencies below 1 ms, ensuring real-time control
