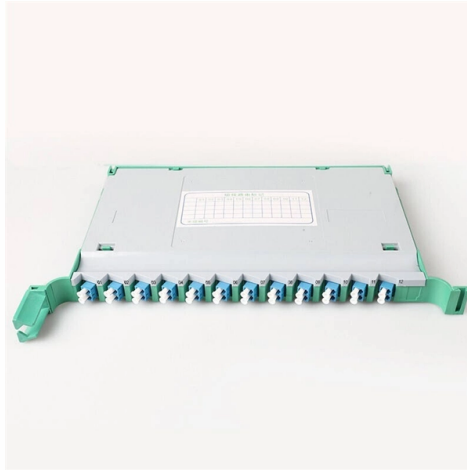


Installation of Embedded Explosion-proof Distribution Box



Article Overview

Proper installation of an embedded explosion-proof distribution box requires strict adherence to safety standards, correct wiring, grounding, and precise positioning to ensure explosion protection and operational reliability.

Pre-Installation Considerations

Before installation, ensure the distribution box is certified for the specific hazardous area (e.g., Zone 1, Zone 2, Zone 21, Zone 22) and that all components, including cables and connectors, are explosion-proof rated and compliant with IEC, ATEX, or NEC standards . Select a dry, ventilated, and low-risk location, away from heat sources, collisions, and corrosive environments . For embedded installations, the wall cavity should allow a 5–6 mm gap around the box for proper sealing and alignment .

Mounting and Positioning

- Ensure the box is vertical and horizontal, with an inclination not exceeding 5 degrees .
- Standard installation height is approximately 1.8 meters for convenient operation .
- If outdoors, fit a rain cover to prevent water ingress and corrosion .
- The mounting frame for switches and busbars should be smooth, unobstructed, and spacious to allow safe wiring and maintenance .
