

Installation of Galvanized Cable Tray Project

Choose the appropriate galvanized tray type (ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom) based on cable type, load, and ventilation needs. Gather tools such as cable tray cutters, bolt cutters, screwdrivers, power drill, wrench set, measuring tape, level, and hacksaw or angle grinder for cutting and fitting .

Step 3: Prepare Supports

Install threaded rods (10mm for trays under 300mm, 12mm for larger trays) and GI slotted C-channels (41x41x2mm) as ceiling or wall supports. Secure them with nuts and washers, ensuring proper spacing (typically 1.5-3 meters depending on tray ty...
