

Installation of Span Cable Trays



Article Overview

Proper installation of span cable trays requires careful planning, correct support spacing, load management, and adherence to safety standards.

Planning and Layout

Before installation, a layout plan should be prepared by a qualified designer or engineer who considers building codes, equipment locations, and clearances for other trades . Elevations for the top or bottom of the tray run should be established using a laser level or transit to ensure consistent alignment . The tray system should follow a predetermined route to minimize unnecessary bends and maintain proper cable management .

Support and Span Considerations

Cable trays must be supported at regular intervals to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity. Center-hung supports allow easier cable installation from both sides . Maximum support spacing typically ranges from 3.6 meters, with load capacities per hanger between 318 kg (700 lbs) and 340 kg (750 lbs) . The spacing and type of support depend on the tray material, load, and environmental conditions .

Cable trays are available in steel, aluminum, stainless steel, and fiberglass, each offering different corrosion resistance and mechanical properties . Aluminum is light...
