

Installation of cooling fans in network cabinets



Article Overview

For optimal cooling, install an intake fan at the bottom and an exhaust fan at the top of the network cabinet to promote efficient airflow and heat dissipation.

Understanding Heat in Network Cabinets

Networking equipment generates heat through power consumption and data processing, and temperatures above 35°C (95°F) can reduce reliability and cause damage. Proper cooling ensures equipment operates within the recommended 18-27°C (64-80°F) range, preventing performance issues and hardware failure (RackCustom) .

Fan Placement and Airflow

- Bottom Intake Fan: Pulls cooler air from outside into the cabinet, taking advantage of natural convection where cooler air is denser and sinks (AC Infinity) .
- Top Exhaust Fan: Expels hot air that rises naturally, ensuring even removal of heat and preventing hotspots (Electronics StackExchange) .
- Single Fan Setup: If only one fan is used, configure it as an exhaust at the top, with passive intake vents at the bottom to maintain airflow (AC Infinity) .

Equipment Layout

- Place high-heat devices near the top or close to the exhaust fan to facilitate heat...
