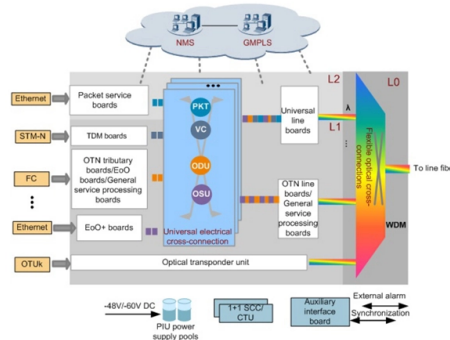


Installation of surge protectors in West Asia power distribution boxes



Article Overview

Effective surge protection in West Asia requires a layered SPD strategy with Type 1, Type 2, and Type 3 devices installed close to the power supply, following IEC standards and regional best practices.

Layered SPD Strategy

Surge protection should be implemented in multiple layers to safeguard sensitive equipment from both external and internal voltage spikes. The recommended approach includes:

- Type 1 SPDs: Installed at the service entrance or main distribution board (MDB) to handle high-energy surges from lightning or utility switching events. These devices are rated for 10/350 μ s waveforms and are mandatory if an external lightning protection system (LPS) is present .
- Type 2 SPDs: Placed at distribution panels or sub-panels to catch residual energy passing through Type 1 devices and protect branch circuits from switching transients. Rated for 8/20 μ s waveforms, they are essential for industrial and commercial facilities .
- Type 3 SPDs: Installed directly at sensitive equipment, such as PLCs, VFDs, servers, or medical devices, providing the final layer of protection at the point of use .
