Network and server cabinets follow international standards such as ANSI/EIA RS-310-D, IEC 60297-2, and DIN 41494 to ensure compatibility, safety, and interoperability across global IT infrastructures.

Key Standards

- **ANSI/EIA RS-310-D:** Published by the Electronic Industries Association, this standard defines the dimensional alignment for 19-inch rackmount equipment, including servers, switches, and patch panels, primarily used in North America. It specifies rack unit (RU) height, mounting hole spacing, and overall cabinet width to ensure consistent installation across devices .
- **IEC 60297-2:** Issued by the International Electrotechnical Commission, this standard provides a global framework for 19-inch racks, harmonizing dimensions and mounting specifications for international interoperability. It serves as a bridge between ANSI/EIA and DIN standards, facilitating OEM and ODM compatibility .
- **DIN 41494:** Germany's DIN standard, particularly Parts 1 and 7, complements ANSI/EIA and IEC standards by detailing rack specifications for industrial control, automation, and electronic test equipment
