

Introduction to the SD signal of the optical module



Article Overview

An SD signal in an optical module refers to a Synchronous Digital signal, typically part of an SDH/SONET network, transmitted as a framed, time-division multiplexed data stream over fiber through the module.

Overview of Optical Modules

An optical module is a hot-pluggable transceiver that converts electrical signals into optical signals and vice versa, operating at the physical layer of the OSI model . It contains a Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly (TOSA), which converts electrical input into modulated light using a laser diode or LED, and a Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly (ROSA), which converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals . The module interfaces electrically with the host system and optically with the fiber network.

Understanding SD Signals

SD signals are the fundamental data streams in Synchronous Digital Hierarchy (SDH) or Synchronous Optical Network (SONET) systems . They are time-division multiplexed (TDM), meaning multiple lower-rate signals are combined into a higher-rate stream in a synchronized manner. For example, an STM-1 frame (the basic SDH unit) carries 155 Mbit/s and is structured in a two-dimensional frame of 9 rows by 270 columns of bytes. The frame includes:...
