Yes, Iran has extensive fiber optic infrastructure, with networks deployed across major cities and provinces, and connections to regional and global networks.

Domestic Fiber Optic Infrastructure

Iran has been actively expanding its fiber optic network, replacing traditional copper cables with high-speed fiber connections. The Telecommunication Company of Iran (TCI) has launched a national project to provide fiber optic access to 27 million users, with provincial capitals prioritized for rollout and copper networks being phased out over the next few years (WANA News Agency) . Major cities such as Tehran, Isfahan, Mashhad, Shiraz, and Tabriz already have significant fiber coverage, with Tehran alone having approximately 245,000 fiber optic ports (Glarity) . Other cities like Rasht, Bandar Anzali, and Astara also have active fiber optic services . In Markazi Province, 224 kilometers of fiber optic cable were deployed in the past year, highlighting ongoing regional expansion (Middle East Observer) .

Strategic and Military Applications

Fiber optic networks in Iran are not limited to civilian use. They are integral to military command and control systems, secure communications, and critical infrastructure monitoring, including energy grids and SCADA systems. These networks are considered strategic assets, with concentrated routes near urban centers, government facilities, and international landing points for submarine cables being potential targets for disruption or sabotage (InTheWarRoom)
