

Is a 20Mbps fiber optic cable compatible with a gigabit router

Compatibility and Setup

- **Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Your ISP typically provides an ONT that converts the fiber optic signal into an Ethernet signal .
- **Connect the ONT to the Router:** Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat5e or higher) to link the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port .
- **Power On Devices:** Turn on the ONT first, wait for the status lights to stabilize, then power on the router .
- **Configure Router:** Access the router's admin panel via a browser (e.g., 192.168.1.1) and enter any ISP credentials if required .
