Deploying fiber optic cable in the DRC is a promising strategy to improve connectivity, despite logistical and financial challenges.

Strategic Benefits

Fiber optic infrastructure offers high-speed, reliable, and scalable internet connectivity, which is crucial for economic development, education, healthcare, and government services in the DRC. Current initiatives, such as the \$1.5 billion project along the Congo River with China's Genew Technologies, aim to deploy 2,100 km of fiber, including 1,700 km along the river and 400 km of terrestrial links, creating major connectivity corridors that bypass difficult overland routes. This approach addresses the DRC's vast territory, poor road conditions, and security risks, which often hinder traditional infrastructure projects.

Ongoing Projects and Regional Integration

In addition to the Congo River corridor, the European Investment Bank (EIB) supports fiber optic expansion in eastern DRC, benefiting over 2.5 million people with faster, cheaper, and more reliable digital connectivity. Regional projects are also underway, including a 10,000 km fiber-optic backbone across Central and Southern Africa, connecting the DRC with neighboring countries and providing access to schools, hospitals, and government institutions. These initiatives indicate strong international support and potential for regional integration.
