A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other end designed for splicing into a fiber optic cable . The bare fiber end is intentionally left exposed so that it can be fusion spliced or mechanically spliced to the main fiber network, allowing light to pass through the fiber core .

Why Light is Visible

When light is injected into the connector end of a pigtail, it naturally travels through the fiber and emerges from the bare end. This is a normal characteristic of optical fibers and does not indicate a fault. The visible light is typically from a low-power laser or LED used for testing or signal transmission. In singlemode fibers, the light may appear as a faint red glow, while in multimode fibers, it can be brighter due to the larger core diameter .
