Deploying fiber optic cables in Sierra Leone is a challenging task due to rugged terrain, heavy rainfall, high costs, and logistical constraints.

Environmental and Terrain Challenges

Sierra Leone's landscape includes mountains, forests, and valleys, which make fiber deployment physically demanding. Engineers working on the National Fiber Backbone Project reported that rugged terrain and constant heavy rainfall significantly complicated cable installation across the country's 721.5-kilometer network covering 15 major cities . These conditions require specialized equipment and careful planning to ensure cables are properly laid and protected.

Technical and Logistical Challenges

Fiber optic installation faces distance limitations, requiring repeaters or amplifiers every 40–60 miles to maintain signal integrity, which adds to costs and complexity . In rural areas, low population density and limited existing infrastructure increase the cost per kilometer, making it harder to justify investment . Additionally, the lack of trained personnel can lead to installation errors, delays, and safety concerns, further complicating deployment .
