

Is the utility pole for fiber optic cable or electrical cable



Overview

A utility pole, typically constructed from wood, serves as a foundational column or post supporting overhead power lines and various public utilities, including electrical cable, fiber optic cable, transformers, and streetlights. Two pairs of shoes can be seen hanging from the wires (center-left, far right). These poles, categorized into transmission, telephone, distribution. Electrical utilities have networks used to transmit and distribute electrical power over a large geographic area. In their served areas will be power generating stations, alternative energy sources (solar, wind, geotherman, etc.), substations for distribution and microgrids. However, there are differences in their appearance, even with those that are black polyethylene. Obviously, these fiber cables need to be resistant to electricity, which can be difficult as many aerial cables contain high tensile steel (HTS) for tensile strength.
