

Joining the Special Optical Cable OS2



Article Overview

OS2 single-mode optical fiber cables require careful handling, adherence to minimum bend radius, controlled pulling tension, and protection from mechanical and environmental damage during installation.

Cable Preparation and Handling

Before installation, ensure the cable reel's protective material remains in place until deployment. Always cover cable ends with end caps or heavy tape to prevent moisture ingress and contamination. Conduct a thorough site survey to identify hazards such as sharp edges, high temperatures, or machinery, and plan the cable route accordingly. Avoid routing OS2 cables near power lines if metallic components are present, and comply with local building codes and regulations during installation .

Pulling and Routing Guidelines

- **Bend Radius:** Do not exceed the minimum bend radius specified for the cable. For loose tube or ribbon cables, the bend radius is typically 20 times the cable diameter during pulling and 10 times during static conditions .
- **Pulling Tension:** Do not exceed the maximum tensile force specified by the manufacturer, often around 600 lbf for OSP loose tube cables . Use a cable breakaway rated at or below the maximum load to prevent over-tensioning.
- **Twist Prevention:** Use swivels at the cable end to prevent twist accumulation. When laying cable on the ground, use a figure-8 pattern to minimize twisting, with loop sizes typically 2-4 meters depending on cable stiffness .
- **Mechanical Protection:** Avoid sharp turns, edges, and excessive pressure points. L...
