Understanding KVM Switch Latency

KVM (Keyboard, Video, Mouse) switches allow a single set of peripherals to control multiple computers. Latency in this context refers to the delay between a user's input (keyboard or mouse) and the corresponding action appearing on the screen. While any additional hardware can theoretically add delay, most modern KVM switches are designed to minimize this impact to levels that are imperceptible in everyday use or gaming .

Factors Affecting Response Time

- **Switch Quality:** High-end KVMs use advanced digital switching and USB passthrough technologies, reducing input lag to under 1ms. Budget or older models may introduce 2-3ms of delay, which can affect reaction times in competitive gaming .
- **Peripheral Compatibility:** Some switches handle high-speed gaming mice and keyboards better than others. Ensuring your KVM supports your peripherals' polling rates (e.g., 1000Hz) is crucial .
- **Cable Length and Quality:** Longer or lower-quality cables can slightly increase signal travel time, though this is usually minimal .
- **Video Resolution and Refresh Rate:** Higher resolutions and refresh rates require more processing, which can marginally increase latency if the KVM is not optimized for high-bandwidth video
