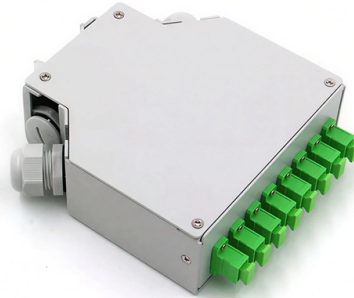


Kenya Level 3 Distribution Box Configuration



Article Overview

A Level 3 distribution box in Kenya is typically a three-phase board designed for commercial or small industrial installations, incorporating main incomers, busbars, MCBs/MCCBs, RCDs, and proper earthing for safe and efficient power distribution.

Overview

Level 3 distribution boxes, often used in commercial or industrial settings, are three-phase units that manage higher loads than residential single-phase boards. They are designed to divide incoming power into multiple circuits, provide protection, and ensure compliance with Kenyan electrical standards and IEC 61439 norms ().

Key Components

- Main Incomer
 - The main supply enters through a main circuit breaker (MCB or MCCB), which controls the entire board and provides overcurrent protection.
 - MCCBs are typically rated up to 250 A for XL³-N 250 and up to 630 A for XL³-N 630 boards ().
- Busbars
 - Copper or aluminum busbars distribute current internally to outgoing circuits.
 - Busbars are sized according to load requirements (125 A, 250 A, 400 A, 630 A) and are insulated and labeled for safety ()....
