

Laying optical cables in indoor vertical shafts



Article Overview

Use OFNR-rated riser cables with proper mechanical support, fireproofing, and careful handling to safely install optical fibers in vertical shafts.

Cable Selection

For indoor vertical shafts, OFNR (Optical Fiber Nonconductive Riser) cables are recommended. These cables are specifically designed for vertical riser applications and comply with the National Electric Code (NEC 2023) for fire safety in multi-story buildings . Backbone cables with higher tensile ratings are preferred for vertical runs because they must support their own weight over multiple floors . Avoid using interconnect or light-duty cables in vertical shafts, as they are not designed for long vertical spans.

Mechanical Support and Conduit

Cables should be firmly secured along the shaft using nylon ties, steel clips, or cable trays at regular intervals to prevent sagging or slipping . In deep shafts or high-rise buildings, consider using conduit pipes capable of withstanding tensile forces and potential impacts from equipment hoisting . Circular shafts are ideal for structural stability, and conduit materials like Pexgol or flame-retardant PVC can handle both mechanical stress and temperature variations during installation .
