

Leading wires from the lighting distribution box



Article Overview

Leading wires from a lighting distribution box should be organized, protected, and connected to individual circuits via terminal blocks and circuit breakers to ensure safety and compliance with standards.

Overview

A lighting distribution box, also known as a sub-distribution board, is the central hub for distributing electrical power to multiple lighting circuits within a building. It ensures safe operation, overload protection, and fault isolation for each lighting circuit. Properly leading wires from the distribution box is crucial for both safety and functionality.

Wiring Principles

- **Circuit Separation** Each lighting circuit should be connected to its own circuit breaker (MCB) or fuse. This allows individual circuits to be isolated in case of overload or short circuit. For example, indoor and outdoor lighting or different zones can be separated for convenience and safety.
- **Terminal Connections** Wires from the distribution box are typically connected to terminal blocks or top-hat rails. These provide a secure and organized point for connecting phase (live), neutral, and protective earth conductors. Flexible cords should not be connected directly to the main terminal block; a separate terminal block is recommended for devices like occupancy sensors.
