- **Installation:** Shorter sections may be preferred in areas with frequent direction changes, tight spaces, or where maneuvering longer sections would be difficult .
- **Transport and Handling:** A 3-meter section is long enough to cover significant distances but short enough to be carried by two people, making it practical for most construction sites .
- **Custom Lengths:** Some manufacturers provide custom-cut sections for specialized applications, though this may involve additional lead time and cost .
