

Lower left corner of cable tray bend



Article Overview

The lower left corner of a cable tray bend is the inner radius area where cables are most likely to crowd, requiring careful attention to bend radius and fill capacity.

Understanding the Lower Left Corner in a Bend

In a cable tray bend, the inner corner (such as the lower left in a horizontal or vertical elbow) is where cables travel the shortest distance. This causes crowding on the inner rail, which can exceed the tray's fill capacity if not properly calculated. Cables on the inside of the bend are compressed together, while cables on the outside travel a longer path, creating uneven spacing and potential stress on the cables ().

Key Considerations

- Bend Radius Compliance: Each cable type has a minimum bend radius. Ensure the inner corner of the bend does not force cables to bend tighter than allowed, which could damage insulation or reduce performance ().
- Fill Capacity: Calculate the tray fill based on the inside radius of the bend, not just the centerline. This ensures the inner corner does not exceed the tray's capacity, especially in high-density installations ().
- Tray Type: Different trays behave differently in bends:
 - Ladder trays allow easy access to rungs and are suitable for backbone cabling ().
 - Ventilated trough trays reduce usable space due to slats but are good for data, coax, and fiber ().
 - Wire mesh baskets are easy to cut and assemble but have lower fill capacity ().
 - Channel trays are restrictive for large bundles but suitable for small cables ()....
