

Maximum delay of fiber optic switch



Article Overview

The maximum delay of a fiber optic switch depends on the number of discrete delay elements and the fiber lengths used, and can be customized up to thousands of discrete delays in advanced switched delay line systems.

Understanding Fiber Optic Switch Delay

Fiber optic switches introduce latency primarily through the routing of signals through optical paths and any associated delay elements. The total delay is the sum of:

- Propagation delay: Time for light to travel through the fiber, typically around 5 microseconds per kilometer in standard single-mode fiber .
- Switching delay: Time required for the optical switch to route the signal through the selected path or bypass elements .
- Equipment delay: Additional latency from modules, amplifiers, or signal processing components in the switch system .

Switched Delay Line Systems

Advanced systems, such as those offered by Optical Zonu, use switched delay line architectures where multiple discrete fiber spools or delay elements are selectable via optical switches. Key points include:

- Number of delays: A system with n discrete delay elements can theoretically realize up to 2^n different delay values
