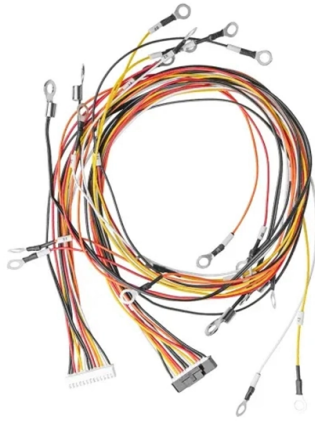


Mesh cable tray left and right bends



Article Overview

Left and right bends in wire mesh cable trays can be created on-site by cutting and bending the tray at the desired angle using bolt cutters or pliers, without the need for pre-fabricated fittings.

Tools and Safety Equipment

- Bolt cutter or cable cutter for cutting wires cleanly
- Pliers or nose pliers for bending and shaping
- Measuring tape and marker/chalk to mark bend locations
- Hand gloves and safety goggles to protect hands and eyes during cutting and bending

Step-by-Step Process for Horizontal (Left/Right) Bends

- Measure and Mark: Determine the location of the bend and mark the wires where the tray will be bent. Ensure the angle is clearly indicated.
- Cut V-Shapes: Using bolt cutters, cut a small V-shape or remove selected side wires at the bend point. This allows the tray to flex without deforming the mesh structure.
- Bend the Tray: Gradually bend the tray to the desired left or right angle using pliers or by hand if the tray is flexible. Make sure the bend is smooth and consistent.
- Reinforce if Needed: For structural stability, use couplers, brackets, or additional wire ties at the bend, especially if the tray will carry heavy cables.
- Check Alignment: Ensure the tray aligns with the intended cable route and that the bend does not create sharp edges that could damage cables.
