

Method for connecting cold splices of drop fiber optic cables

Cold splicing of drop fiber optic cables is achieved using mechanical connectors that align and secure the fibers without fusion, providing a fast, reliable, and low-cost connection.

Overview of Cold Splicing

Cold splicing uses mechanical connectors to join two fiber ends precisely. Unlike fusion splicing, it does not require a welding machine or heat, making it ideal for field installations, FTTH drop cables, or temporary repairs. The main components of a cold splice connector include a ferrule, which holds the fiber in place, and a body, which secures the ferrule and maintains alignment with the other fiber (ZRCable) .

Required Tools and Materials

- Cold splice mechanical connector
- Fiber stripper
- Fiber cleaver or cutting knife
- Lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol
- Optional: optical power meter or OTDR for testing
- Fiber drop cable clamps or anchor clamps for outdoor protection (VictoryEle)

- Prepare the Fiber: Strip approximately 3 cm of the outer jacket from each fiber an...
