

Method for representing the specifications of curved cable trays



Article Overview

Curved cable trays are specified using bend angles, radii, and functional descriptions to ensure proper routing, structural integrity, and compliance with standards.

Key Methods for Specification

1. Bend Angle and Radius Curved cable trays are defined by their bend angle (e.g., 30°, 45°, 90°) and radius of curvature, which ensures cables are not stressed beyond their minimum bend radius. The radius is critical for maintaining cable performance and avoiding damage, especially for power and instrumentation cables . Each bend type should have a separate specification if multiple angles are required .
2. Functional Descriptions in CAD Modern CAD systems allow the use of functional descriptions to represent curved trays. For example, a 45° bend is assigned a functional description, and the CAD software verifies that the geometry of the tray matches the intended angle. This ensures consistency between design intent and physical components .
3. Material and Structural Properties Specifications should include material type, finish, and mechanical properties such as section modulus and moment of inertia for side rails and rungs. This ensures the tray can support the cable load and maintain structural integrity through bends . Common materials include steel (galvanized or stainless), aluminum, and fiberglass-reinforced plastics, selected based on environmental conditions .
4. Compliance with Standards Curved cable trays must comply with NEMA VE 1, NEC Article 392, and UL classifications. Specifications should reference these standards to ensure safety, proper installation, and regulatory compliance . Minimum bend radii for cables exiting the tray are also...
