- Wall-Mount Clamps: Secure cables to walls or overhead structures, suitable for temporary or semi-permanent installations .
- D-Ring Clamps: Hook around the cable and lock in place, often used in ceilings or suspended locations without crimping the fiber .
- Surface-Mount Clamps: Attach directly to floors, walls, or equipment racks, providing a low-profile solution in confined spaces ...
