Preparation and Safety

Before connecting fiber optic cables, gather the necessary tools: fiber optic strippers, cleavers, fusion splicers, cable connector kits, optical power meters, visual fault locators (VFL), and safety equipment such as gloves and safety glasses . Always work in a clean environment to prevent contamination of the fiber ends, which can degrade signal quality . Follow industry standards like ANSI/TIA/EIA and NEC Article 770 for safety and compatibility .

Cable Handling and Routing

Plan the cable pathway carefully, considering bend radius, tensile limits, and future expansion space . Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling force, as these can cause microbends or breaks that reduce performance . Use cable management tools such as velcro straps or trays to secure excess cable and prevent tension .

Termination and Connector Installation

- **Strip and Clean Fiber Ends:** Remove the outer jacket and coating using a fiber stripper. Clean the exposed fiber with isopropyl alcohol and lint-free swabs, inspecti...
