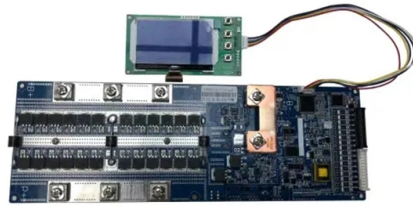

- Protection: The splice is covered with a heat-shrink sleeve or protective enclosure to restore mechanical strength and environmental resistance. Fusion splicing produces extremely low insertion loss, typically around 0.02-0.1 dB, and minimal back reflection, making it ideal for high-performance, long-distance, or mission-critical networks. It is highly durable and resistant to environmental changes, vibrations, and temperature fluctuations, which is crucial for heavy-duty cables deployed outdoors or in industrial settings .
