- **Fiber-to-the-Antenna (FTTA) Cables:** These cables run from the base of the tower up to the antennas, often including both fiber and electrical conductors in a single armored jacket. FTFA cables reduce weight, simplify installation, and replace multiple coax cables .
- **Hybrid Trunk Cables:** Combine high-performance fiber with copper power conductors, allowing simultaneous data and power transmission. These are designed for macro cell towers and long cable runs, improving efficiency and reducing installation time .
- **Pre-terminated Jumper Cables:** Short, high-flexibility cables connect radios and equipment at the top of the tower. They are factory-configured to minimize field splicing and ensure consistent signal quality
