

National Standard Cable Tray Weight and Standards



Article Overview

Cable trays in the U.S. are governed primarily by NEMA VE 1/VE 2, UL 568, and NEC Article 392, with weight and load capacities defined by material, type, and span.

Cable Tray Standards

NEMA VE 1 specifies the manufacturing requirements for metallic cable trays, including ladder, channel, wire mesh, and solid bottom types, along with associated fittings. It defines load/span classes, material types, and finishes for steel, aluminum, and stainless steel trays, ensuring compliance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) for safe installation and support of power and control cables . NEMA VE 2 provides installation guidelines, including support spacing, handling, and environmental considerations, ensuring that trays maintain structural integrity under load . UL 568 covers nonmetallic (fiberglass) cable trays, specifying performance requirements for continuous systems, including ladder, ventilated, solid bottom, and channel types . IEC 61537 is the international standard for all-metal and nonmetallic cable trays, detailing requirements for support, accommodation of cables, and testing for mechanical and electrical performance . NEC Article 392 outlines installation requirements, permissible wiring methods, maximum fill, and grounding considerations for cable trays in the U.S. .
