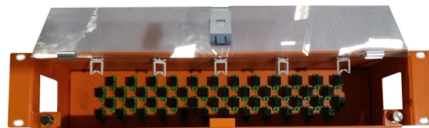


National Standard Fiber Optic Drop Cable Specifications



Article Overview

The standard national model for FTTH fiber optic drop cables is typically the GJXFH/GJYXFH butterfly (figure-8) cable, compliant with ITU-T L.110 and YD/T 1997-2009 standards.

Overview

Fiber optic drop cables are the final segment connecting the distribution point to the subscriber's premises, delivering broadband, TV, and voice services. They are designed for high-speed, low-loss transmission and can be deployed aerially, underground, or indoors depending on environmental requirements .

Standard Models and Specifications

- GJXFH / GJYXFH (Butterfly / Bow-Tie Drop Cable)
- Structure: Flat figure-8 cross-section with two FRP (Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic) strength members flanking a single fiber in a central or offset groove.
- Fiber Type: Typically G.657 bend-insensitive single-mode fiber, suitable for tight bends with a minimum radius of 20 mm .
- Tensile Strength: $\geq 500\text{N}$, providing crush resistance and durability.
- Applications: Ideal for aerial self-supporting installations and short-distance indoor/outdoor connections.
