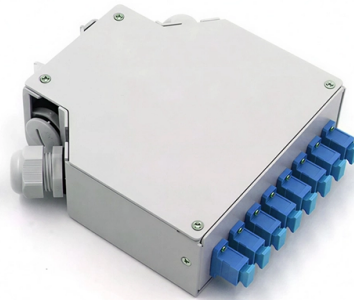


National Standard for Distribution Box Sockets



Article Overview

Distribution box sockets must comply with national and international standards such as IEC 61439 and BS 7671 to ensure safety, proper installation, and reliable operation.

Key Standards

IEC 61439 is the international standard governing low-voltage switchgear and control gear assemblies, including distribution boxes. It specifies safety requirements, layout, and testing procedures for devices used in domestic, industrial, and construction site power distribution. IEC 61439 is divided into multiple parts: IEC 61439-2 for power switchgear and control assemblies, IEC 61439-3 for distribution boards, and IEC 61439-4 to 7 for specialized applications such as worksite power distributors, public distribution units, and charging stations . In the UK, BS 7671 (IET Wiring Regulations) serves as the national standard for electrical installations. It covers circuits up to 1000 V AC or 1500 V DC and provides requirements for design, installation, inspection, and testing of fixed electrical installations, including distribution boxes and socket outlets. BS 7671 mandates protective measures such as RCDs, AFDDs, surge protection devices, and proper earthing and bonding to ensure safety .
