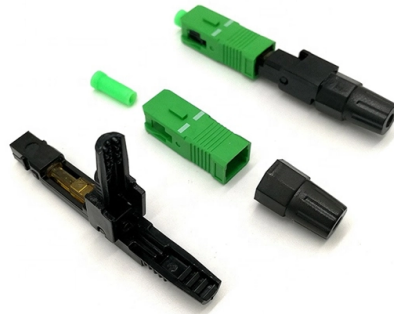

Overview

The National Optical Cable Trunk Line (NOCTL) is a backbone network designed to interconnect major cities, regions, and communication hubs across a country. It serves as the primary conduit for high-speed data, voice, and internet traffic, supporting both public and private telecommunications services. The network typically uses optical fiber cables capable of transmitting data at speeds ranging from 10 Gbps to multiple terabits per second, depending on the technology deployed.

NOCTL employs multi-fiber trunk cables, similar in concept to MPO/MTP trunk cables used in data centers. These cables integrate multiple optical fibers within a single sheath, allowing dozens to hundreds of parallel high-speed channels. Key features include:

- High fiber density: A single trunk cable can carry 48, 72, 96, or more fibers, reducing the number of physical cables required and simplifying network management.
- Pre-terminated connectors: Factory-tested MPO/MTP connectors ensure consistent transmission quality and plug-and-play installation, minimizing field splicing and de...
