Project Overview

The Nepal KVM Fiber Optic Line Project, led by Nepal Telecom, involves deploying All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) optical fiber from Manma (Kalikot) to Gamgadhi (Mugu) via Jumla. This project replaces older microwave radio links with fiber-optic transmission, providing faster, more reliable internet and telecom services in some of Nepal's most remote and rugged areas . The ADSS technology ensures a durable, high-speed network without the need for metal reinforcement, making it suitable for challenging terrains .

Technical Features

- Fiber Type: ADSS optical fiber, which is self-supporting and resistant to environmental stress .
- Transmission Upgrade: Shift from microwave links to fiber-optic lines, enabling higher bandwidth and lower latency .
- Backup Routes: Redundant transmission paths ensure uninterrupted connectivity even during disruptions .
- Integration: Supports FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) services, mobile broadband, and IPTV services, with speeds up to 200 Mbps in some districts .
