A network cabinet, sometimes called a server rack, is a physical frame or enclosure that organizes and secures network and server equipment, including routers, switches, patch panels, and servers . It provides a centralized location for hardware, ensuring accessibility, security, and efficient space utilization. Network cabinets come in standardized dimensions, typically measured in rack units (U), which allow compatibility with most IT equipment . They can be open-frame or fully enclosed, with features like perforated doors, integrated fans, and cable management pathways to optimize airflow and cooling .

What is a Chassis?

A chassis is the enclosure that houses the internal components of a server, such as CPUs, memory, storage drives, and power supplies . Chassis can be designed to fit inside a network cabinet or server rack. Some chassis accommodate a single server, while others, like blade server chassis, can hold multiple server modules in a compact form factor . Essentially, a chassis is the modular unit that contains the compute resources, whereas the cabinet provides the structural framework to hold multiple chassis....
