General Placement Guidelines

Switches and routers are usually installed in the upper or middle portion of the rack. This placement allows for easy access for monitoring, maintenance, and connecting network cables without interfering with heavier servers below. Patch panels are often positioned near switches to minimize cable lengths and simplify organization, ensuring a clean and manageable cabling system (). Servers are generally mounted in the middle to lower sections of the rack. Heavier servers are placed lower to maintain stability and reduce the risk of tipping. Blade servers or rackmount servers are installed according to their unit height (U) and weight distribution (). Power distribution units (PDUs) and UPS systems are typically installed at the rear or bottom of the rack to provide centralized power while keeping cables organized and out of the way ().
