Determining the Number of Circuits

The exact number of circuits depends on the types of loads and areas served:

- Lighting circuits: Usually one for each floor or major zone.
- Power outlets: Separate circuits for different rooms or floors to prevent overloads.
- Kitchen appliances: High-power devices like microwaves, ovens, and refrigerators often require dedicated circuits.
- HVAC and air conditioning: Each unit typically needs its own breaker.
- Bathrooms and outdoor areas: Require special protection and dedicated circuits.
- Future-proofing: Add 20-30% extra slots for potential additions like EV chargers or solar panels .

Practical Guidelines

- Calculate total load: Sum the wattage of all appliances and devices, then divide by voltage to determine the current for each circuit .
- Dedicated circuits: Critical equipment such as furnaces, sump pumps, or medical devices should have their own breakers to avoid interruptions .
- Spare capacity: Always leave extra slots in the distribution box for future expansi...
