Installation Methods for Duct Fiber Optic Cables Installing duct fiber requires specialized techniques to navigate ducts (which may have bends, joints, or obstacles). The two most common methods are pulling and air blowing —each with unique advantages and use cases. Note that Recommendation ITU-T L. ulling has been the first technology for installing OF cables in duct. It. – refers to single-mode optical fibre cables installed by the pulling method to be used for telecommunication networks in ducts and tunnels; – recommends that optical fibre dimensional and transmission characteristics should comply with one or more of [ITU-T G. These ducts act as a protective pathway, shielding the fiber from environmental hazards. Corning Optical Communications cable specification sheets are available which list the maximum tensile load for various cable types.
